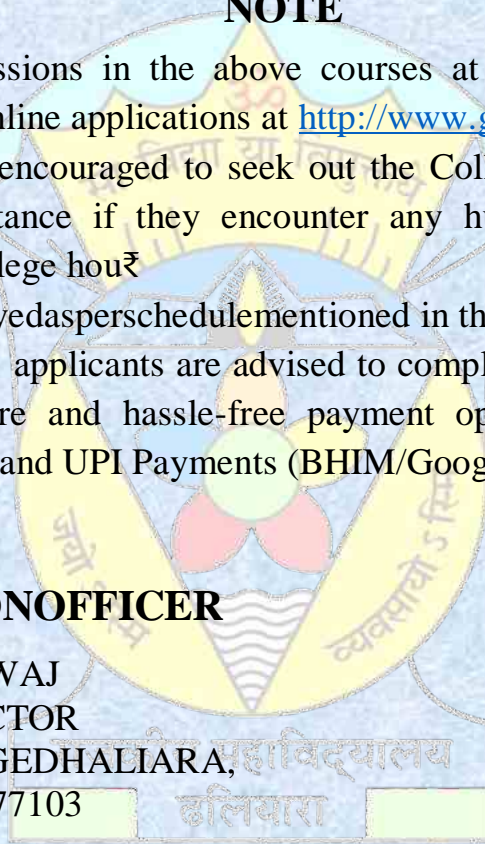

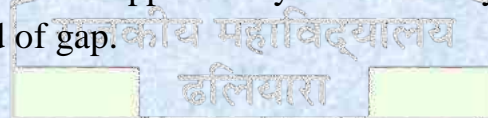

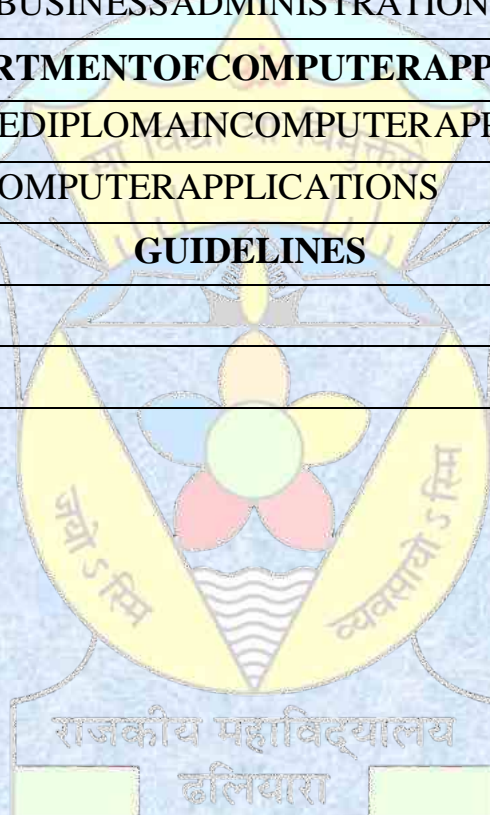

1. **MATRICULATION CERTIFICATE** (Class 10 Certificate with detail of Marks).
2. **SECONDARY SCHOOL CERTIFICATE** (Class 12 Certificate with Detail of Marks).
3. **HIMACHAL PRADESH DOMICILE CERTIFICATE** (For exemption in tuition fees for female students only).
4. **QUOTA AND CATEGORY CERTIFICATE** (In case of candidates seeking admission against any reserved seats including Sports/Cultural or Handicap Quota (Minimum of 40% Disability Certificate)
5. **CHARACTER CERTIFICATE** (From Head of the Institution last attended. In case of private candidates, the character certificate must be issued by a Gazetted Officer/ Panchayat Pradhan/ Ward Counsellor and should not be older than 6 months from the day of submission of admission form)

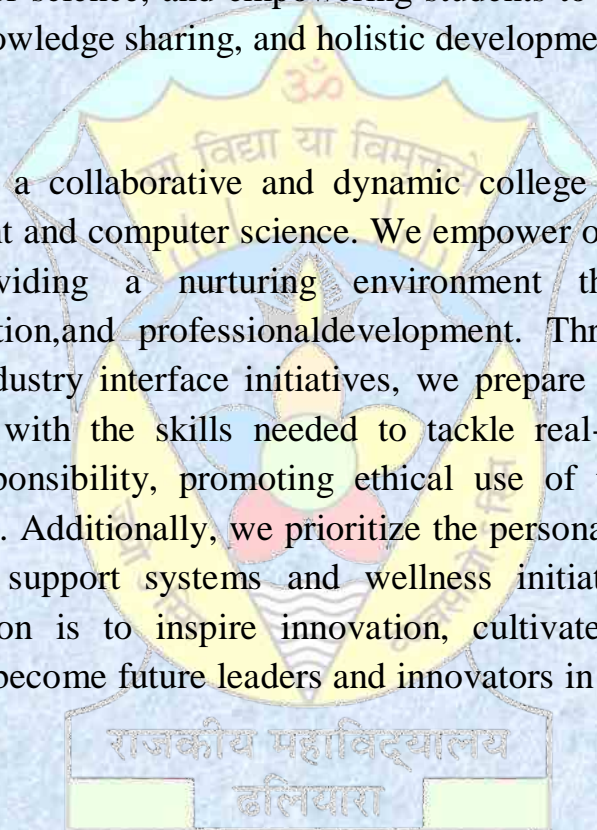

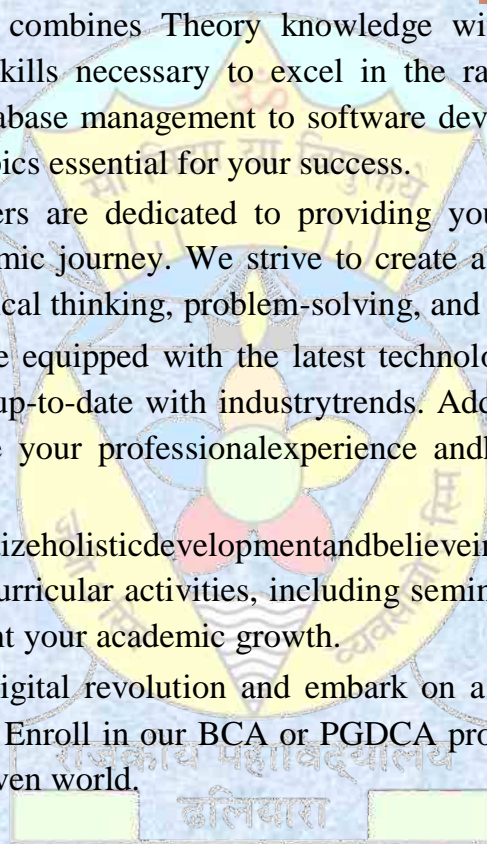

## **AVAILABILITY OF SEATS**

The Masters of Business Administration (MBA) programme is a two years course, divided into four semesters. At the end of each semester, students are required to take an examination as prescribed by the university. The total capacity for the MBA course is planned to be 60 seats which will all be in the subsidized category.

Government College, Dhaliara accepts 60 students in the MBA Course and these seats are filled according to Himachal Pradesh University standards. The 120 point roster as recommended by the HPU is being followed for reservation of various categories for the session 2026-27 for admission to the MBA course.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Bachelor Degree in any discipline from any University established by law in India, with at least 50% aggregate marks (45% marks in the case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Candidates).
- Candidates who are appearing for their final examination of Bachelor Degree examination in April/May, 2026 shall be allowed to appear in HP University Management Aptitude Test (HPU-MAT), but the final selection is subject to their satisfying the eligibility condition.

## **AGE LIMIT**

Except for Non-subsidized, serving or retired defense personnel, the maximum age limit is 26 years for boys and 28 years for girls (29 years in case of SC/ST candidates both for boys and girls) as on 1st of July of the year concerned. Provided that the Vice Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation for reason to be recorded in writing up to a maximum of six months. Provided further that age bar shall not apply in case of non-subsidized students, defense personnel, State/ Government of India nominees.

## **FEE STRUCTURE**

The Fee Structure for MBAs is as below

- Subsidized Seats: ₹31,919/- per annum.

It is for the information of the students that the cost of the Mandatory Industrial Tour will be borne by the students themselves. The college does not collect any fee in this regard.

Note:

- a) The student admitted to the course of MBA will be governed by the rules and regulations of the institution and university combined.

## **REFUNDABLE LIBRARY SECURITY FEE**

An amount of ₹1000/- will be charged extra as library security fee at the time of admission.

## **PTA FUND**

In addition to above mentioned fee structure PTA fund of ₹ 1000/- will be charged from each candidate per semester.

## **UNIVERSITY DEVELOPMENT FUND**

For Subsidized Seats: ₹500/- per student

For IRDP/BPL Candidates: ₹250/- per student

## **EXAMINATION & MIGRATION FEE**

Examination, Migration Fee & other charges will be as per the guidelines from Himachal Pradesh University.

## **MANDATORY CONDITIONS TO APPEAR IN END SEMESTER UNIVERSITY EXAMS**

To be eligible to appear in University Exams the student must at the end of each semester fulfill certain conditions. The conditions are laid below:

1. Attendance should be at least 75% in Theory subject.
2. On-the-Job training and its presentation and preparation of report is mandatory to appear in the examination.

## Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes with Multiple Entry Multiple Exit as per NEP 2020

## AVAILABILITY OF SEATS

The BACHELOR of Business Administration (BBA) programme is a three years course, divided into six semesters. At the end of each semester, students are required to take an examination as prescribed by the university. The total capacity for the BBA course is planned to be 60 seats, which will be distributed as follows:

1. Subsidized Seats
2. Non-Subsidized Seats

Government College, Dhaliara accepts 60 students in the BBA Course and these seats are filled according to Himachal Pradesh University standards. The 120 point roster as recommended by the HPU is being followed for reservation of various categories for the session 2026-27 for admission to the BBA course as per Annexure 1 attached.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) with any stream or other examination equivalent to a Board/University Established by law in India with at least 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST Candidates).

Or

Any examination of a Board/University/College/School in a foreign country recognized as equivalent for the purpose of eligibility by the Vice-Chancellor/Equivalent Committee or on the recommendation of Association of Indian Universities.

## AGE LIMIT

The maximum age limit for admission is 22 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2026. However, in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories the upper age limit will be raised by three years i.e., 25 years as on 1st July of 2026. The Vice-Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation for reasons to be recorded in writing, up to maximum period of three months.

## BASIS OF ADMISSION

### subsidized Seats

Admission shall be made on the basis of merit list determined on the basis of marks obtained in Senior Secondary Examinations (Class 12 Examination). The Himachal Pradesh University 120 points roster is being followed for admission to BBA and reservation of various categories for the session 2026-27. It shall be followed from 41- 80 points..

## **Non-Subsidized Seats**

This applies only to NRI's Payment Categories. In case of NRI's, this scheme admits students as per the merit in the past examinations passed by the candidate. Top 20 NRI's candidates shall be admitted to this programme.

Proof of status in the case of NRI's. For this purpose, either of the following documents shall be considered as a proper proof:

- i. Copy of the Non-resident card/Employment card issued by the employer.
- ii. Photocopy of the immigration card/employment VIS A entry on the passport along with details of passport.
- iii. Certificate issued by Indian Embassy/High Commission in the country where the NRI is residing.
- iv. Photocopy of the latest assessment order of income Tax Authorities either in India or the country of Employment filled in the status of NRI.

In case of non-availability of NRI's, the seats under Non-subsidized category will be filled on First Come First Serve basis.

To Resolve a Tie: In case of tie, the candidate having higher aggregate marks in the qualifying examination shall be admitted first. If the tie is still not resolved the candidate younger in age will be admitted first.

## **FEES STRUCTURE**

The Fee Structure for BBA is as below

- Subsidized Seats: ₹5,300/- per semester
- Non-Subsidized Seats: ₹10,300/- per semester

Note:

- a) The student admitted to the course of BBA will be governed by the rules and regulations of the institution and university combined.

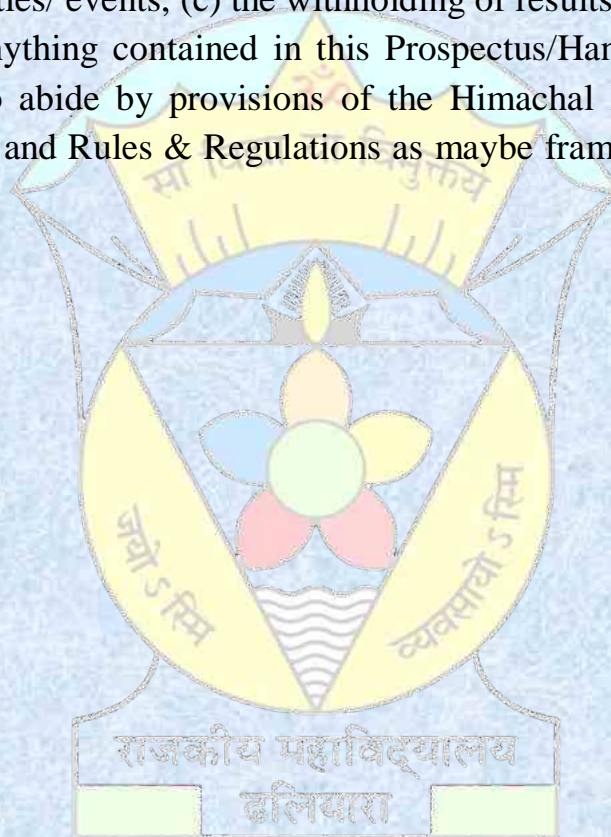

Candidates who have passed Senior Secondary Examination (Class 12 Examinations) from H.P. Board/CBSE/ICSE or any other examination considered equivalent to Senior Secondary, by the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla-5 with 45% Marks (40% marks for SC/ST category) shall be eligible.

## AGE LIMIT

Maximum age limit for admission to BCA course is 21 years for Male candidates and 24 years for SC/ST Category and 23 years for Female candidates as on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2026. The Vice Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to maximum of three months.

## BASIS OF ADMISSION

The admission to BCA course will be made on the basis of merit of the qualifying examination. As per University rules 75% seats will be filled out of the candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination from the school situated in the Himachal Pradesh irrespective of the Board. 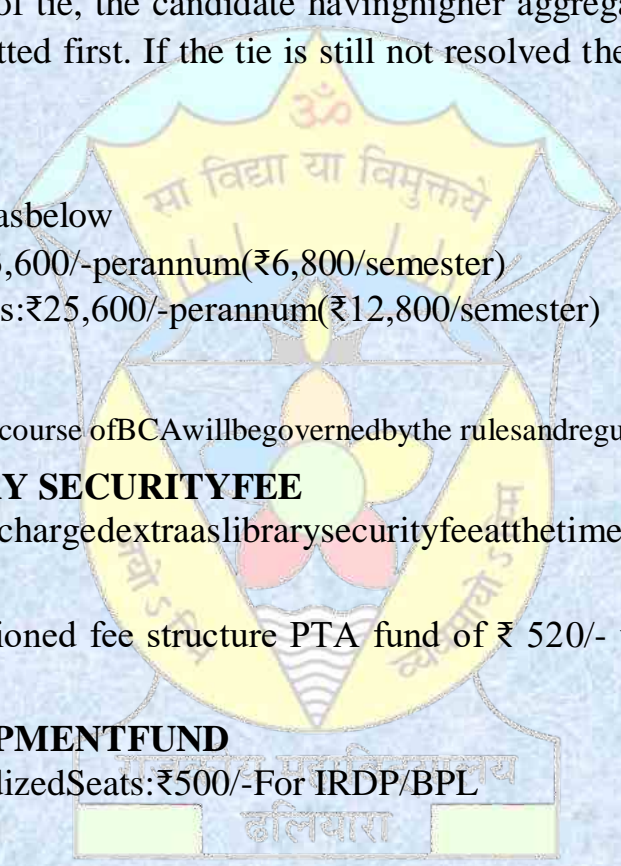

## ANNEXURE II

### RESERVATION OF SEATS

(A) 15% and 7.5% seats shall be reserved for SC and ST candidates respectively, having domicile of Himachal Pradesh – irrespective of the Institutions from where they have passed their qualifying examination.

(B) The remaining 77.5% seats shall be filled as under:

1. 25% of the seats for admission shall be open for all the candidates irrespective of the institution from where they have passed their qualifying examination.
2. 75% of these seats shall be filled out of the candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education or any other school located within the territorial jurisdiction of H.P. or any other school boards e.g., CBSE or ICSE etc. or in case of PG Courses candidates have passed their qualifying examination from HP University or HP Krishi Vishwavidyalaya Palampur or Dr. Y. S. Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, HP Technical University and Central University of Himachal Pradesh or the candidates who are Himachal domicile irrespective of passing qualifying examination from any other University established by Law in India which is equivalent to the qualifying examination of Himachal Pradesh University, subject to the following reservations:
  - a) 5% of these seats shall be reserved for outstanding Sportsmen/Women.
  - b) 5% of seats shall be reserved for outstanding cultural activists.
  - c) 5% of seats shall be reserved for physically handicapped candidates.
  - d) Provided that the minimum eligibility for admission to the course in the case of SC/ST will be 5% lower than the eligibility condition for other students.
  - e) The rules of Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla shall be applicable in the case of above reservations in the college.

*Total management seats will be 10% of the seats for Himachali Bonafide candidates i.e., 10% of 42 seats in case of 50 seats and 10% of 85 seats in case of 100 seats allotted to the Colleges as per Orders of the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. vide CWP No. 4500 of 2009 dated July 29, 2010. The management seats will be filled up by the management of Institute on the basis of merit of the Entrance Test through its own counseling in a transparent manner. There shall be no reservation, whatsoever, in respect of the prescribed management quota seats. The basic eligibility criteria shall remain the same as in case of other students.*

## **SPORTS SEAT SHALL BE FILLED ACCORDING TO FOLLOWING RULES**

- Sportsmen / Women seeking admission to any course offered by the college should be eligible to play in the Inter-College / Inter-University Championship as per rules and regulations for Inter- University Tournaments.
- Admission against outstanding sports quota would be made once in the beginning of the academic session. No forms for such admission would be entertained after the expiry of the last date of the submission of forms for admission in the University.
- Only those Sportsmen/Women would be considered for admission against outstanding sports quota, who have represented the University or State in the Inter-University or Inter-State Championship Tournaments respectively.
- The Sportsmen/Women seeking admission against outstanding sports quota should also qualify the minimum eligibility conditions for admission in that course as provided under the rules.

*In order to judge the suitability of players for admission in the sports quota, trials would be held in the respective games/sports, by a committee to be constituted by the Director of Physical Education and Youth Programmes, who will be the Chairman of the Committee and the recommendation of the committee would be kept in view while giving admission. The original certificates would also be seen by the Committee at the time of trials. In case a certificate is issued on the Association pad, it should be duly signed and stamped by both the President and the Secretary of the respective Association.*

The admission against sports quota would be given to such candidates who have represented the University state in the inter- university/inter State competition in the following games.

### **Men's Section**

*Hockey, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Wrestling, Boxing, Table Tennis, Badminton, Cross- Country, Cricket, Athletics, Weight Lifting, Handball, Chess, Kho-Kho, Judo, Taekwondo and other games included in the list of Inter College tournaments by the Sports & Co- curricular Activities Council of Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from time to time.*

### **Women's Section**

*Hockey, Athletics, Basketball, Volleyball, Table Tennis, Badminton, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Hand Ball, weightlifting, Boxing, Cross-Country Judo, Chess, Taekwondo and other games included in the list of Inter College tournaments by the Sports & Co- curricular Activities Council of Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from time to time.*

- For students who are given admission on sports basis, it will be compulsory to attend the sports activities (in his/her sport) regularly.
- Any student, who without adequate reasons is found to be avoiding his / her games / sports activities, will be liable for disciplinary action, leading to the cancellation of his / her admission.

## **CULTURAL SEAT SHALL BE FILLED ACCORDING TO FOLLOWING RULES**

- Admission against outstanding cultural quota at par with sports quota would be made once, in the beginning of the academic session. No forms for such admission would be entertained after the expiry of the last date of the submission of forms for admission in the University.
- Candidates who are employed are not eligible for admission against cultural quota in any of the courses.
- Only those students will be eligible for admission against outstanding cultural quota who are having at least I, II, III in Inter-School Cultural Competition in any of the previous three year

*In order to judge the suitability of the candidates for admission against cultural quota, trials would be held in the respective cultural items by a committee comprising coordinators and two persons to be nominated by the Principal-cum-Director and the recommendations of the committee will be final. Original certificates would be seen by the Committee at the time of trials.*

While considering admissions against cultural quota only the following cultural items will be considered

*Debate, Indian Folk Dance, Indian Classical Music (Vocal), Indian Classical Music (Instrumental), Light Vocal Music, Vadya Vadan, Group Singing, Indian Classical Dance, One Act Play/Short Play/Skit, Symposium, Poetic Symposium, Spot Painting, Quizzing, Western Group Song, Western Solo, Rangoli, Clay Modelling, Elocution, Poetic Recitation, Cartooning, Collage, Poster Making Photography, Folk Dance, Orchestra and mimicry.*

Note: The Distinction in the individual item will be given preference over the Team Items. The students seeking admission against outstanding cultural quota should also qualify the minimum eligibility condition for admission in that course provided under rules.

- For students who are given admission on cultural quota basis it will be compulsory to represent the College at various events in cultural activities.
- Any student who without adequate reason is found to be avoiding his / her cultural activity, will be liable for disciplinary action leading to the cancellation of his/her admission.

As per the Hon'ble High Court in case No.642 of 2006, Abhishek V/s Himachal Pradesh the admission under cultural quota will be made on the basis of marks obtained in Entrance Test/qualifying examination. The trials would be held to judge the suitability of the candidates only. For the selection under cultural quota, those candidates are entitled to be admitted in the course, which possess higher merit in the entrance test/qualifying examination than other.

(d) Any other reservation rules of Himachal Pradesh University shall be applicable if no suitable sportsman, cultural candidate and physically challenged candidate is available than the seat/seats will be offered to general category.
